PITTSBURGH — Vice President Kamala Harris used a joint campaign appearance with President Joe Biden in the critical swing state of Pennsylvania on Monday to say that U.S. Steel should remain domestisay that 0.3. steel should remain to mean-cally owned — concurring with the White House's monthslong opposition to the company's planned sale to Japan's Nippon Steel

Steel.

Her comments came during a rally before cheering union members marking Labor Day in the industrial city of Pittsburgh, where Harris said U.S. Steel was an historic American company and it is vital for our country to maintain strong

"an historic American company and it is vital for our country to maintain strong American steel companies."
"U.S. Steel should remain American-owned and American-operated, and Iwill always have the backs of America's steelworkers," she said.
That echoes Biden, who repeated Monday what he's said since March — that he opposes U.S. Steel's would-be sale to Nippon, believing it would hurt the country's steelworkers. It's little surprise that Harris would overlap with Biden on the issue, but nonetheless constitutes a major policy position for the vice president, who has offered relatively few of them since Biden abandoned his reelection bid and endorsed his vice president in July.
Biden took the stage first and was met with chants of "Ihank You, Joe" as he and Harris appeared in an International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers hall.
The president called Harris the only "rational" choice for president in November. He

He said choosing her to be vice president was the single best" decision of his presidency and told the union members that electing her will be "the best decision you will ever make." Biden also started to say, "Kamala Harris and I are going to build on this" as if he were still running and she was his running mate — but he corrected himself. For 25 years, the massive mural at the northeast corner of Broad and Spring Garden has stood as a symbol of Black pride and artistic spirit for Philadelphia. The mural's future, however, is in doubt as the area north of Center City continues

to be overtaken by a large amount of new

In 1998 renowned artist Meg Saligman turned the side facade of the building into a captivating work of art. As with other projects across the city it was supported by Mural Arts Philadelphia.

The large artwork was created on the west side of the former Thaddeus Stevens School, which was used by the School Dissopool.

Accounts of the incident on Accounts of the incident on Monday have varied, with the campaign insisting there were no violations of the law, while cemetry officials have said Trump's team was told ahead of time to avoid political activity. Federal law prohibits political carmpaigning or election-related activities within Army National Military Cemeteries, according to a statement from Arlington National Cemetery Arlington National Cemetery obtained by CNN.

A video of the visit posted by the Trump campaign on TikTok showed the former president walking through Arlington and visiting grave sites, with audio of him criticizing the Biden administration's management of the US withdrawal from Afghanistan.

NPR first reported there had been a "verbal and physical altercation" during the cemetery visit. A source with knowledge of the incident told the outlet that a cemetery official attempted to prevent Trump's team from photographing and filming in the area where recent US casualties are buried. In response, Trump campaign staff "verbally abused and pushed the official aside," according to NPR.
